Description		
Since some days with current 3.1 master if I start a fresh project and load OSM as xyz it will not zoom to 'world', but stays on 0,0 scale 1:1700. Meaning I'm seeing a nice blue screen and I have to either zoom out a couple of times, or use 'Zoom to Layer'. Before I always zoomed to the world extent of osm. To reproduce: - remove ~/.local/share/QGIS to be sure you have a clean profile - start QGIS (and not it starts in EPSG:4326) - from browser open osm layer from XYZ tiles - see bleu screen as in attached image Note that if you then resize the screen, Remove the osm layer Load the osm layer again: all is fine: you will see the world.
