<p>When loading a WMS, which is using HTTPS protocol, HTTP requests are sent out only.</p> <p>You can see the requests in "Log Messages" or using a proxy server: it's HTTP only (and fails, if the server doesn't redirect to HTTPS).</p> <p>This bug appears at least in build d48818b492.</p>

Addition: of course, you can see the errors in "Log Messages" only. Better use a proxy.
