<p>In QGIS 2.14, the ftools plugin provided the ability to create a rotated vector grid.</p> <p>This option was not moved to the processing plugin functionality.</p> <p>One reason might be that older versions of ftools (like that used in QGIS 2.8) did not have that rotation support either.</p> <p>For a possible usecase, see https://gis.stackexchange.com/questions/258912/how-to-create-a-grid-inside-a-polygon-that-is-oriented-with-the-longest-side</p>
