<p>In the graduated symbology 'Class' column, one can manually set the upper and lower range of the class.</p> <p>Doing so opens the 'Enter Class Bounds' window where the Upper value appears on the bottom, and Lower value appears on the top. (see image)</p> <p>It should probably be flipped so that Upper value is at the top and Lower value is at the bottom :)</p>
