If we run r.mapcalc in graphic mode, then we copy the resulting command in the GRASS shell, it throws an error, eg: <pre>r.mapcalc raster_sum=((raster1+raster2))</pre> bash: syntax error near unexpected token @(' If we add apices, it works: <pre>r.mapcalc raster_sum='((raster1+raster2))'</pre> same if we remove the parentheses: <pre>r.mapcalc raster_sum=raster1+raster2</pre> Looks an easy fix.
