#### Description

I have 2 tables postgres in relation one to many among them, connected with the classic fkey. I created a form that contains both tables using relationships. If I create a new parent and also a child record, qgis fails to save the child because it tries to assign the string value to "nextval ('gid\_seq'::regclass), since the parent's primary key has not yet been assigned". In practice I am forced first to save the father (exiting the form) and only then create the child record. At the moment I solved using a uuid field as fkey but it's just a patch, not the behavior I would expect in a form.
