It displays properly in the properties window, layers panel, map layer, print composer, and legend items list. However, in the legend itself, it will only display as a solid black line. I have tried adjusting the symbol width and height, icon spacing, and box spacing, but it does help. The custom dash pattern is set with Map units (ft).</p> <p>(The problem went away when I made the custom dash pattern using pixels, so maybe this is only a minor problem...)</p>
