# Description

I have used a plugin extensively in the past called Layer Combinations to assist with turning different layers on and off in a panel window depending on the map features were to be displayed using a dropdown menu selection of saved combinations with an easy update button.

Layer combination features have been merged in QGIS a long time ago; they are present in 2.14 (called "preset visibility" and I think this is why the plugin got no updates for years) and in 3.x they are called "map theme".
