<p>In QGIS 3.2, the split vector layer tool has the option to output to a temporary folder. But the user has to search through the temporary files on their computer to find the output from this tool. On my computer, I eventually found the output in a folder called C:\Users\...\AppData\Local\Temp\processing_06d3ebcccd43405387054798e6b8efb9\b215e3c7f0e6409c873c9b7f1d6507bc\OUTPUT. It's not a huge bug, but it gives the impression that this tool simply doesn't work.</p> <p>This issue would be fixed by adding an option to automatically add the output to the current project.</p>
