<p>If PostGIS table (with defined "geoemetry-type" column) constains at least one record storing "MultiPoint" type geometry, it causes that in Browser (Browser -&gt; PostGIS -&gt; database_alias -&gt; public -&gt; geometry_types) a polygon-type entry are not displayed, thus blocking access to this kind of objects.</p> <p>Removing from database MultiPoint record and refreshing list in Browser -&gt; PostGIS makes this geoemetry visible again.</p>
