<p>Open the Style Manager dialog</p> <p>Click the "Export/import symbols" button and select "export symbols"</p> <p>Press "Select by group" and choose a group/tag to use</p> <p>Press Close (btw, it should be better labeled OK)</p> <p>On my windows computer, selection are barely visible. While a direct selection with mouse highlights the item in blue, using the "select by group" option adds a gray light background only on labels.</p> <p>You then wonder if any item has been selected... (at least, it's hard to identify which item is being selected)</p>
