<p>I just upgraded to 3.2.1, and something weird is happening with printing and exporting. All print and settings set to A4, my printer now responds saying the its the wrong paper size, even though the printer tray is clearly set to A4. Whenever I go and open Page setup it says User Defined at 287mm x 210mm. Which is not anything I defined, So I change to A4, and get the same error. The setting keeps reverting to this user defined value. In the print dialigue I set A4, but that doesnt seem to help. I have tried setting up new blank projects, I have tried with a different Tray and page size (A3) but the same happens.</p> <p>I have never had this before - it would be great if someone could suggest why it might be happening.</p>
