<b>Description</b>	
<p>I use Josm for OpenStreetMap editing and I find two mouse behaviour very useful:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Use the right-click and drag to pan the map</li><li>- When zooming with the mouse wheel, keep the map point under the mouse pointer fixed</li></ul> <p>This allow to pan and zoom the map quickly, using just the mouse without swtiching tool.</p> <p>I think that it is very useful and it does not conflict with current behaviour.</p>

Instead of right-click/drag there is Middle button panning available, although I believe it is not documented. There is also using the space bar to pan without switching tools, as described in the User Guide. The keyboard - arrows and pgup, pgdn for move and zoom - can be used as well.
