It seems like the layer panel does not detect whether a layer is selected or not.</p> <p>tested for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- *.shp</li><li>- *.gpkg</li><li>- PostGIS</li></ul> <p>In 3.2.1 / 2.18.23 this is not an issue.</p> <p>Loading a *.shp file via drag&amp;drop also does not show this issue.</p>
