<b>Description</b>		
<p>Hi,</p> <p>I often need to import several SHP-files into my PostgreSQL DB.</p> <p>In QGIS v2.18.4 the DB Manager kept the focus on the schema I've chosen for the first file.</p> <p>In newer versions of QGIS (I tried 2.18.12, 3.0.3 and 3.2.3) I must select the schema again after each import.</p> <p><b>Way to reproduce:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- open more than one shape file in a QGIS version &gt;= 2.18.12</li><li>- open the DB Manager and select the schema you want to import the SHPs into</li><li>- import the first SHP</li><li>- now you'll recognise that the selection of the schema jumps back to the superior database the previously selected schema is located in</li><li>- now you must reselect the schema you want to import the SHPs into <b>this is the step which was'nt necessary in QGIS v 2.18.4 and earlier</b></li></ul> <p>Greetings,</p> <p>Joern</p>
