<p>Issue Summary:</p> <p>It is very difficult to load/set a default style from a SpatialLite database, despite having created the style appropriately as the default for a layer.</p> <p>The style picker seems to ignore the default style for the layer you want to load it onto, and setting a loaded style as Default to the database simply creates a copy of the already existing valid style.</p> <p>Screen cap of the behavior:</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=sIZ1w3IEDLs</p>
