<p>A colleague of mine tried to install the latest version of QGIS on mac downloaded from QGIS.org. It's the QGIS-macOS-3.4.0-3.dmg package. Compared to earlier packages, GDAL is not included, and the installer complains:</p> <p>"The GDAL 2.3 framework is required."</p> <p>And then stops. Normally in these packages GDAL is installed first and then QGIS but in this package there is no GDAL.</p> <p>Are you supposed to download GDAL on your own? Seems like something has changed.</p>
