Description

User Feedback

When I make a connection to postgis when starting a project that needs that connection, and then after some time close QGIS, it crashes. It seems as if a postgis connection time-out causes the crash. I've had it several times during the past few weeks, since the upgrade to 3.4 from 2.18. I installed QGIS with OSGeo4W64.
