<p>Rechecking check boxes in the QGIS UI is not possible in Ubuntu.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Example: Saving a layer's style- The check boxes to choose categories can be unchecked, but not rechecked.- After saving a layer style with certain category boxes unchecked, it is impossible to recheck them next time a style is saved.- The only way I found to reset the check boxes to a checked state was to delete the qgis3.ini file for the user on the computer (wiping all customization done to the QGIS UI). <p>Another related issue is setting certain flags with python does not seem possible.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Example: Setting flags for custom map themes with python.-QgsMapCanvas setTheme() python function does not set the flag
