I'm having the same problem on 2 different Mac machines (both running Mojave). It started with 3.4.2 and its still there on 3.4.3. My whole system freezes when using the "file picker" window. I can move my mouse around, but I cannot interact with any thing during the freeze.

I tried completely uninstalling QGIS (and python, GDAL) and reinstalling, but I still get the freezing.
