| <p>Current functionality:</p> <p>When I place an attribute table in my layout, I can only order the rows based on columns that are visible in the table.</p> <p>Desired functionality:</p> <p>I should be able to order my data on any columns in the table, whether visible or not. For example (see attached image), I have a table right now where I've included numbers to dictate the order certain items appear in the table (entry_order). I don't want the column itself to show in my attribute table, but the only way I can use it for ordering is to have it visible in the table.</p> <p>Seems like this is an easy fix.
