I have attached a simple model that creates points from a text file. The steps are:

- 1) Run model
- 2) Select data source. I use [https://earthquake.usgs.gov/earthquakes/feed/v1.0/summary/4.5\\_day.csv](https://earthquake.usgs.gov/earthquakes/feed/v1.0/summary/4.5_day.csv) as input.
- 3) Specify log file
- 4) Run model
- 5) Open the new log file, which is empty, even though the model runs fine.

By the way, when I have defined a log file, I don't see any indication (such as the file name) that I have specified a log file. Wouldn't that be informative for the user? This might be a separate ticket, though.
