<p>I cannot edit any vector features in QGIS 3.4.4.</p> <p>To recreate - load a Shapefile of GeoPackage or create a memory layer in QGIS (point, line or ploy). Toggle Editing, select the Vertex Tool, move cursor over the map canvas.</p> <p>As soon as my mouse cursor moves over the map canvas a pop-up appears saying "Exception - Unknown Exception". The pop-up cannot be dismissed, it can only be dismissed if I move my mouse cursor outside the map canvas. Also, turning off Render (lower right) does not remedy the problem. As a result, I cannot edit any vector features in QGIS. The issue also occurs with the Add Feature tool.</p>
