<p>The "documentation" file https://github.com/qgis/QGIS/blob/master/python/plugins/processing/algs/grass7/grass7.txt seems not to be up-to-date. The instructions there-in, i.e. the various declarations used in the description files under https://github.com/qgis/QGIS/tree/master/python/plugins/processing/algs/grass7/description are not mentioned. Also, the format of the declarations seems not to be what is described in the grass7.txt file.</p> <p>For example, for a Raster map, the documentation reads</p> <pre>ParameterRaster base base False</pre> <p>while declarations in existing description files are</p> <pre>QgsProcessingParameterRasterLayer input Name of NDVI raster map [-] None False</pre> <p>In this example, not only the declaration "keyword" itself is different ("ParameterRaster" vs. "QgsProcessingParameterRasterLayer") but also the number of succeeding elements as well (3 vs. 4).</p> <p>I am trying to follow what is under the descriptions directory. But I still don't understand all of the formatting.</p>
