<p>Extent option <i>Use Layer Extent...</i> in processing algorithms (i.e. <i>Extract/clip by extent</i>) doesn't work. Other two options (<i>Use Canvas Extent</i>, <i>Select Extent on Canvas</i>) works fine.
