#### Description

When in the Data Source Manager, under Mesh I can browse to an XMDF but it won't load, with a ".xmdf is not a valid or recognized data source." error.

When using the file browser in the Data Source Manager XMDFs do not appear at all as they are not an allowed file type.

Do we have the wrong version for native XMDF mesh capabilities or is something wrong without our installation?

The XMDF file represents datasets. That means data that sits on top of the mesh frame. In this dialog you mentions, you need to select 2DM file, not XMDF file.
