<b>Description</b>	
<p>I joined a table layer to some geodata. Now some features got new attribute values while others got NULL values.</p> <p>It would be very handy to be able to quickly assess the success of a join.</p> <p>For that one would need to see:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The total number of features on the parent layer (the one joined TO)</li><li>- The number of features on said layer for which a matching row in the JOINED layer was found</li></ul> <p>The Layer Properties -&gt; Joins dialog could get a new column for that, showing e.g. "123/5000" or "5000/5000". I added two rough mockups.</p>
