<p>When I installed go2streetview the plugin had only a blank spot on the tool bar to run it, I thought this was an issue with the plugin and didn't think much of it. After installing SwapVectorDirection the go2streetview icon appeared but the SwapVectorDirection icon does not display. If I deactivate go2streetview the SwapVectorDirection icon will appear. I can still run the tools I just need to find the blankspot on the tool bar. Not sure if any onther plugins are afflicted by this.</p>
