<p>When using Processing GRASS algorithms in batch mode, the GRASS_REGION_EXTENT_PARAMETER is not shown.</p> <p>This happens in QGIS 3.4.7 and QGIS 3.6.2, but seems ok in 3.7 (master).</p> <p>To reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Run a GRASS algorithm. For instance, v.to.rast. In 'Advanced parameters' you see "GRASS GIS 7 region extent (xmin, xmax, ymin, ymax) [optional]".2. Run the same algorithm as Batch Process.3. Toggle to advanced mode.4. The "GRASS GIS 7 region extent (xmin, xmax, ymin, ymax)" column is not shown.
