This bug is similar to #2318. But there's one difference: 1. If you check "map unit" without classification, map symbols are scaled correctly 1. if you check "map unit" WITH classification, map symbols are NOT scaled steps to reproduce: 1. load a point layer 2. open symbology properties (the old) 3. select "unique value" 4. get all values for a field 5. select a value 6. set the size and check the "map unit") 7. click OK 8. ZOOM IN / OUT the symbols are never scaled
