<p>When attempting to install <i>qgis0.74</i>, a number of libraries where also required to be installed, but the show stopper came when <i>libgdal1</i> was required. This in turn required <i>netcdfg3</i>.</p> <p><i>netcdfg3</i> conflicts with <i>libnetcdf3</i>.</p> <p>When I looked into the Synaptic Package Manager to remove <i>libnetcdf3</i> it informed me that doing so would also remove <i>ubuntu-desktop</i>.</p> <p>I decided that this would be very unwise to do.</p> <p>Do you have any suggestions?</p>

ubuntu-desktop is a meta-package, meaning it doesn't contain anything. Instead, it depends on everything that came with a clean install.

Looking on my Dapper system, and [<http://packages.ubuntu.com>],

qgis depends on **libgdal1c2a**, which depends on **libnetcdf3**

I can't find libgdal1 or netcdfg3.
