When attempting to install qgis0.74, a number of libraries where also required to be installed, but the show stopper came when libgdal1 was required. This in turn required netcdfg3.

netcdfg3 conflicts with libnetcdf3.

When I looked into the Synaptic Package Manager to remove libnetcdf3 it informed me that doing so would also remove ubuntu-desktop.

I decided that this would be very unwise to do.
