<p>Using the mapserver export plugin, a layer which has labels does not find a 'LABELITEM' line in it's mapfile anymore. This worked in older versions, but is apparently broken in current version.</p> <p>It looks like it has something to do with a change in the project-file format.</p> <p>Currently a 'maplayer'-element has 3 'label'-elements, the plugin code is broken because of this.</p>
