<p>If map with curved labels is printed, intervals between chars is too small.</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) create any linear vector layer;2) add some features with non-NULL text attributes;3) go to Layer->Labeling, enable new labeling for this layer, select curved placement;4) add print composer, add map, export map to pdf;5) labels will be almost unreadable in PDF file.
