<p>Non-exhaustive testing shows:</p> <p>with a project loaded, double-clicking or otherwise maximizing the main QGIS window will cause the following sequence of events:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-window is made bigger, toolbars etc. are loaded</li><li>-canvas is white at this point, shortly afterwards (during redraw ?) QGIS crashes.</li></ul> <p>Only tested on winXP, QGIS version 1.5.0-2 binary package.</p>

After a bit more testing, I've found this:

- number or type of layers is irrelevant
- crashes only if the Overview window is open and has at least 1 layer marked as "display in overview"
- doesn't crash on minimize/restore

I just updated to 1.6.0, and the bug is still present. Remember the overview window has to be activated and displaying at least 1 layer. This similar to #2884, which I am also plagued by.

I did get behaviour of the overview not displaying, however if undocked the overview window it did display consistently on zoom, maximise minimise etc.
