| <p>Currently the feature form is only accessible when the user clicks on a feature with the info tool, opens <i>actions</i> and clicks on <i>view feature form</i> (three clicks). From a plugin developer's point of view it would be very handy to have an API method available to open the feature form for a certain feature.</p> <p>Example: new feature is created by plugin from some sort of user input (selection, clicks...) and added to the layer, feature form pops up automagically.</p> <p>This issue has been discussed on the Qgis-developer mailing list.</p> | | |
