<p>Sometimes SVG markers which contained centered text labels looks in QGIS a little differ than in another software like browsers or vector graphic editors. In such cases label is moving to left side of marker. For example: [http://gis-lab.info/images/screenshots/20101104-e59-50kb.jpg] Example of svg marker in attachment.</p>
