<p>When exporting from the print composer to svg or an image, the exported file has a white background and a very thin grey border. In some (most?) cases it is desirable to have no border and/or to have a transparent background. These could be added as options on the "General" tab in the print composer.</p> <p>It may be desirable to have all the options: Frame colour, Background Colour, Opacity and Outline Width, like on the "Item" tab. But I don't think the background is as necessary as the other options.</p>
