#### Description

Today I got a notice that my Plugins Starter Plugin may be upgraded from 0.3.1 to 0.3.2. So I go to **Plugins** > **Fetch Python Plugins**, select **Plugins Starter Plugin**, and hit **Upgrade plugin**.

Even though I get a dialog saying **Plugin reinstalled correctly**, it never actually upgrades. The **QGIS Python Plugin Installer** dialog still shows **0.3.1** -> **0.3.2** for that plugin's version.

Even if I close qgis and restart, I get the same problem. I even tried running qgis as an administrator (right-click on its Start Menu icon and select **Run as administrator**), and that doesn't fix it.
