Description <p>I don't know if the following suggestion is better suited for a composer enhancement or a for a plugin suggestion, I'll leave this to you (Marco), in case close this ticket and I'll open a "plugin idea" one on the plugin trac.</p> <p>Regularly it pops out the question/request by someone asking about if QGIS can create mapbooks.</p> <p>I used to create mapbooks years ago (on proprietary software), when working on the field, and I know that this feature can be really useful.</p> <p>The idea is the following: create a layout then choose a scale, a paper size and orientation and a % of overlapping.</p> <p>A mapbook tool will then create many layouts (pdf files, or directly to the printer) by fitting the layout into the page size. Each layout will show a portion at the chosen scale of the original layout map and each layout map will overlap the near ones with the chosen %.</p> <p>A "overview" sheet should be also produced to show all the mapbook "pieces" (usually numbered).</p>
