in [[QgsMapCanvas]]::CanvasProperties the mouseButtonDown class member is not initialized. This causes the keyboard panning and zooming not to work until after a mouse click occurs on the map canvas. The behavior may depend on the platform -- I noticed this on Windows. to demonstrate: 1. start QGIS 2. load a layer or project; the focus should be on the map canvas 3. use an arrow key to pan - nothing happens 4. click the mouse on the map 5. now an arrow key will pan
