<p>Using Shapefile. 1.7.0 Build #15820. Not sure if GUI is the correct component for this...</p> <p>1: Attribute Table upward scrolling mouse selection. Go to last record (bottom). In Editing Mode or Not In Editing Mode: Left-click on record # and drag up to select records... (a) Table does not scroll above current extent. (b) The count of # features selected in the window title bar does not update. This causes problems when trying to run calculations on (apparently) selected records that are not actually selected.</p> <p>On the other hand, there are no problems when scrolling upward while selecting. This was unexpected.</p> <p>2: Attribute Table selecting and scrolling with shift key. Click to select any record. Shift + Up Arrow or shift+page up/page down does not extend the selection. This was unexpected.</p>
