I just tried "Save as shapefile" for a [[PostGIS]] layer on Linux - clicking on it does not seem to trigger any reaction. Is it supposed to work? If this matters: I have loaded the [[PostGIS]] layer with a subselection (applied a WHERE clause while loading).

I am probably lagging behind SVN HEAD for 1-2 weeks since I have to update to QT 4.2 (which I'll do now).
