- 3) Click on rule "(no filter)" and then click on Refine->Add categories.
- 4) Select "Column" attribute.
- 5) Select attribute used to rotate the symbol in Advance->Rotation field.
- 6) Change the symbol to the arrow symbol.
- 7) Click on "Classify" and then OK
- 8) Click OK and you will see that all of the arrows are pointing up rather then in the direction stored in the attribute specified in 5)
