I have a remote server that i mount in Ubuntu 11.04 with ssh / sftp. I'm using qgis 1.7.0 Wroclaw

Steps to reproduce:

- 1.- Open the remote server in nautilus (the file explorer of ubuntu)
- 2.- Double click on the shp file to open it in qgis
- 3.- Open the attribute table and begin edition
- 4.- Change some value
- 5.- Close edition

All the rows of the dbf get NULL values, not only those which you edited.
