Description <p>Methods to save a file are different in different commands and plugins, e.g.:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- sometimes the file extension has to be chosen, sometimes not- sometimes the file format cannot be chosen (e.g. for interpolation plugin)- the target directory is not always the same. <p>We should have an uniform method, and use it consistently.</p> <p>Similarly for Open file.</p>
