<p>Apparently the diagrams are not allowed to superpose each other. When the size of the diagram (as defined in the "diagram overlay" tab of the "layer properties" window) is big enough for the diagrams to superpose each other, they just disappear without warning.</p> <p>version 1.7</p>
