I set the 'ref' field as a text layer.</p> <p>When I zoom, QGIS will crash whatever the version is.</p> <p>It will not crash if I change the text layer value from 'ref' to 'name' or any other field when i am zooming.</p> <p>Strange, do you mind what could happen?</p> <p>It is strange, why for a value, not another?</p> <p>The lines are rendered as rules set as follow:</p> <p>((line = 'bus') AND (ref = '16'))</p> <p>I give you the file, but I doubt it will be useful without the right database, but I join you the data set.</p> <p><http://www.box.com/s/nibrax4ag5cyvt6vor13></p>
