<p>Running v1.7.3 'Wroclaw' on 64 bits windows 7 machine.</p> <p>Qgis consistently crashes when I inspect project properties (settings-&gt;project properties) if I use WMS layers within that project.</p> <p>Specifically, I was fetching a background map over Europe from <a href="http://wms.geonorge.no/skwms1/wms.europa">http://wms.geonorge.no/skwms1/wms.europa</a>. My project has CRS WSG-84 utm zone 33. If I delete the WMS layer I can inspect project properties all I want.</p> <p>Additional information: code rev.00624b3, GDAL/OGR v 1.8.1, postgresSQL client v. 8.3.10, spatiaLite v 2.4.0, QWT v 5.2.1.</p>
