<p>Hi,</p> <p>in the field-calculator to fill a field of the attribute-table, should be really useful a function like the "repeat(S text,N integer)" to produce a new string with N times the string S, like as exmaple:</p> <p>repeat("0", 10) ==> "0000000000"</p> <p>This is really useful to produce a code-block using it with the "length" functin.</p> <p>as this example:</p> <p>= repeat("0",10-length(\$rec)) field(\$rec)</p> <p>this will produce a code-block like this:</p> <p>0000000001 0000000002 0000000003 0000000004 0000000005 ... 0000000009 0000000010 0000000011</p>
